our community approach over time, responding to feedback and evolving local needs.



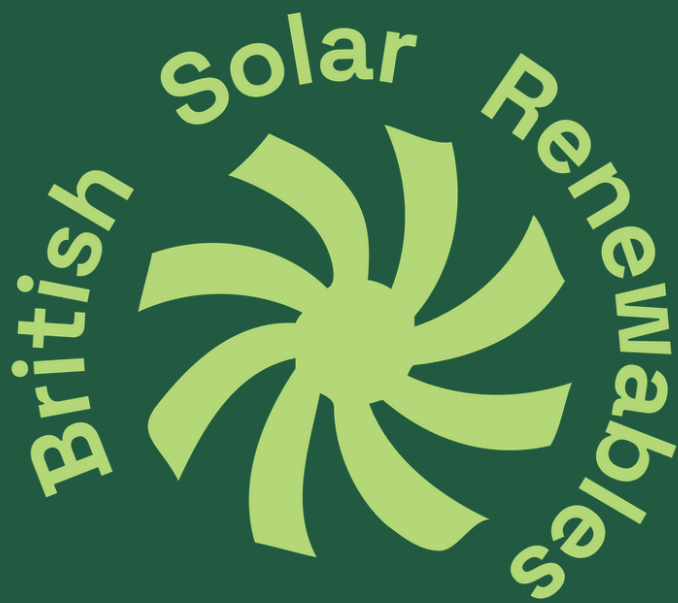


A SHARED COMMITMENT
